MEET FORMAT This will be a "Cardless" meet with double ended preliminaries.

WARM UP PROCEDURES SNC warm up procedures will be in effect at this meet.

ELIGIBILITY Swimmers must be registered with SwimBC in one of the SNC competitive categories, or with another FINA-affiliated National swimming organization.
A standard of 4:00.00 or faster for the 200IM is required to participate in this meet.

TIME STANDARDS

- * There are no Standards for 50m and 100m events.
- * BC 'A' Time standards for all 200m events except 10&Under 200Fr 3:40.00.
- * **Proof of Time (POT) required for 200m events. Report to be sent via email.**
- * Open entries to Kamloops Classic swimmers.

ENTRY INFORMATION

1. 600 swimmers will be accepted to the meet.

2. **FEES:** \$8.00 per Individual Event
\$12.00 per Relay Event
\$4.00 Swim BC Provincial Team Splash Fee
\$.50 Okanagan Swimmer Surcharge
Entry fee invoices will be available at check-in.
Cutoff date to receive changes or scratches via email will be noon Monday Dec 5th.
Payment must be made by check-in on Friday December 9th.
We accept cash, cheque, Interact, Visa or Mastercard [5% surcharge for use of debit or credit card].
Cheque payable to "Kamloops Aquatic Club".

3. Meet entries must be submitted through the SNC meet website. **Proof of times must be emailed** in word or pdf format to meets@kamloopsclassicswimming.ca by Monday November 28th deadline.

4. **No "NT"** entries will be accepted. There are no entry standards for relay events; however, please enter times for seeding. Relay cards will be provided.

5. Swimmers are limited to a **MAXIMUM OF 8** individual events.

SCORING:

Points for club standings will be assigned according to Club registration submitted.
Team scoring for Finals will be: 18-16-15-14-13-12-11-10
Team scoring for Consolations Finals will be: 9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1
Relay scoring will be: 36-32-30-28-26-24-22-20

MEET RULES:

- 1) This meet will follow current SNC rules and the current SNC swimsuit policy will be observed.
- 2) Deck Entries will be accepted to fill any empty lanes and:
 - (a) Must be in the hands of the Clerk of the Course 30 minutes before Session starts.
 - (b) Deck entries available to those swimmers already entered in the meet.
 - (c) Are Exhibition Swims Only (i.e., for time only; not eligible for finals) that will be seeded in the 1st available lane in the 1st available heat.
 - (d) \$15.00 per event or relay to be paid at time of deck entry request.
- 3) Para-swimmers must be entered with their classification numbers and actual times for each event. 2011 IPC rules will apply to all Para-swimmers in the meet.
- 4) There will be **Positive Check-ins for Distance Events and must be completed by 8:00am each day.**
- 5) **SPECTATORS AND NON-ACCREDITED COACHES ARE NOT PERMITTED ON DECK.**
- 6) In order to allow the meet to proceed in a timely fashion, Meet Management reserves the right to alter the meet format by one or more of the following:
 - a) Swim the 10 & under girls' events in the same end of the pool as the boys' events for heats
 - b) Limit the number of entries in the 200m events.
 - c) Change start times to an earlier time.Meet Management will notify all teams with changes that were deemed necessary, no more than 72 hours after the entry deadline.

SCRATCH RULES:

- 1) No-shows, step downs and unexcused incomplete swims will be considered a late scratch in Finals, and thus subject to penalty. There shall be no penalty for a "late scratch" in preliminaries.
- 2) The initial scratch deadline for Finals each night will be 30 minutes following the completion of morning preliminaries.
- 3) The last scratch deadline for Finals will be 30 minutes prior to the start of the Finals session; the Clerk of Course AND alternate's coach MUST be notified by the coach of the scratching swimmer prior to this deadline. Any scratches, no-shows, etc. after this time shall be considered a late scratch.
- 4) Late scratches (as defined above) in Finals will be subject to the late scratch penalty of \$20, plus removal from all other events, including relays, on that day. This levy must be paid before any other members of that swimmer's team can compete.

MEET FORMAT:

- 1) Age groups will be: 10 & under, 12 & under, 14 & under, 15 & over.
- 2) All events will be swum together during heats, but separated for Finals.
- 3) All 10 & under events including relays will be swum as timed final events during the preliminaries and will be seeded slowest to fastest.
- 4) Relays (except 10 & under) will be swum as timed finals at the end of Finals.
- 5) Girl's 800 and Boy's 1500 free events will be seeded and awarded as Open Age Group events. Top 24 per gender.
- 6) 400Fr and 400IM are timed finals limited to top 24 swimmers per age group per gender and will swim during heats as Open Age Group. Top 8 per age group per gender to swim during Finals.
- 7) There will be Consolation Finals if there are 24 competitors or more as determined by the psych sheets in the following events: All 50's & 100's, 200 Free and 200IM.
- 8) These events will have "A" finals only: 200 Back, 200 Breast, 200 Fly
- 9) A Coaches Meeting will be held prior to the start of the meet (Friday AM).

AWARDS:

- Age will be determined as of Friday, Dec. 9, 2011.
- Medals will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place; ribbons will be awarded for 4th through 8th place. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st 2nd and 3rd place relay teams.
- Best Time ribbons will be given to 10 & under swimmers.
- The winning team will receive the Ice Classic Cup; the winning small point team will receive the Mini-Ice Classic Cup (Team sizes to be determined at start of Meet).

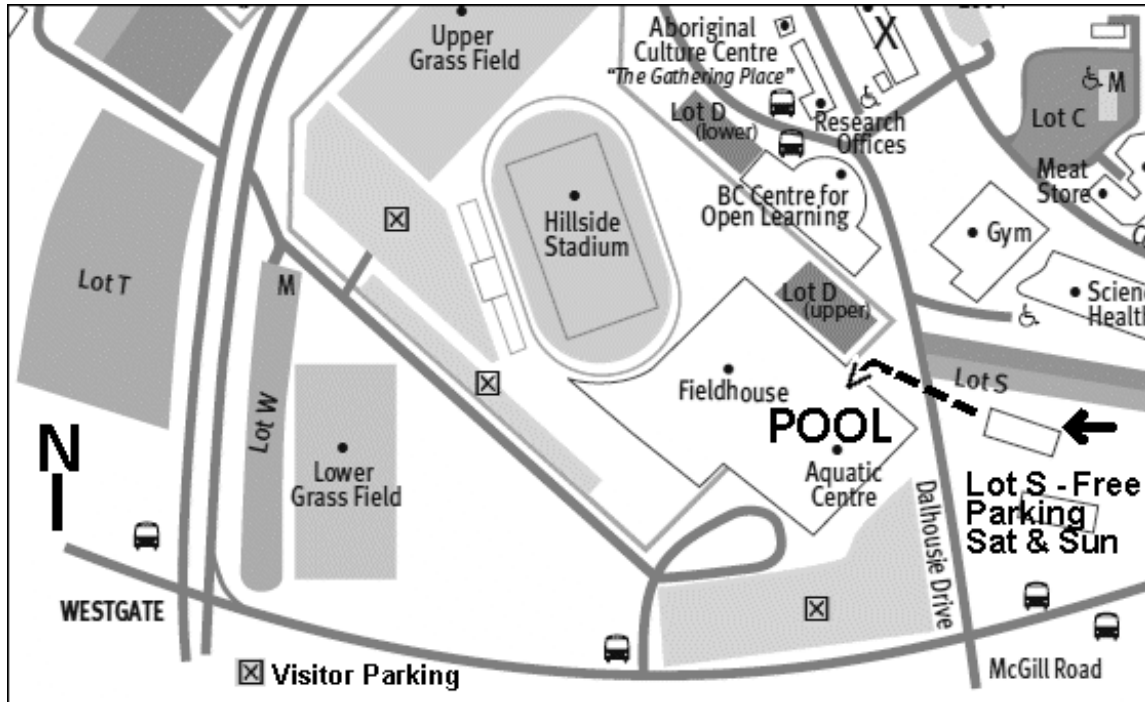
