Meet Format: Preliminary sessions will be senior seeded, by gender. Finals will be 12 & under,

13-14 and 15 & over. A finals only. 800 Free and 1500 Free will be time finals

limited to the top 16 entrants of each gender.

Meet Rules: The meet will be governed under current Swimming Canada rules.

Eligibility: All swimmers currently registered with SNC or members of associations affiliated

with FINA are eligible.

There are no qualifying or de-qualifying standards for this competition.

Entry Limit: 300 swimmers. Swimmers are limited to 7 individual events.

Entry Times: Entry times are required for all entries. Entries with No Times (NT) will not be

accepted. Please estimate a time for a swimmer.

Entry Fees: \$8.00 per individual event

\$10.00 per relay event

Entry Deadline: Meet entries and fees are due to the meet manager by May 24, 2013.

Scratch Deadline: Scratch deadline for refunds will be May 24, 2013.

Scratches: Prelim Scratches are to be submitted to the Clerk of Course

30 minutes prior to the start of each Prelim session.

Scratch Deadline for Finals is 30 minutes from the conclusion

of the heats on the day the final is to swim.

The Last Scratch Deadline shall be 30 minutes prior to the start of the finals session. However, there shall be no reseeding to include scratches made after the initial scratch deadline. The Last Scratch Deadline only applies if the following procedures take place. Firstly, the referee, the coach and/or alternate for the event scheduled has been notified of the impending scratch by the coach of the swimmer who scratched. Secondly, the alternate has reported to the Clerk

of Course and is prepared to swim the event.

Relays: Relays will be at the end of finals.

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded 1st-8th place in all individual events and 1st-3rd place in

relay events.

Officials: Visiting teams parents are encouraged to help with officiating. There is limited

seating at the pool. Please contact Terriane Bowyer/Maxine Sawicki at

Deck Entries: Will only be accepted if no additional heats are created. All deck entries are

exhibition swims and not eligible for scoring/finals. Deck entries must be

approved by the meet manager and will cost \$10 each.
