# Eligibility

- All competing swimmers must be registered with SNC, USS or a FINA recognized organization.
- The qualifying period is between **September 1, 2011 and May 2, 2013**.
- Qualifying time must be at or above Alberta "A" Standards (Under 12 must use 12 year old "A" time)

# **Entry Deadline**

- Entries are due April 18, 2013
- Changes to entries as well as scratches without penalty will be accepted until **Friday**, **April 26**, **2013** once the entry file has been received prior to the deadline.

## **Entry Limits**

- Swimmers may enter up to 4 bonus swims to a maximum of 8 individual events.
- "Bonus swims" must be at or above the Alberta "B" time standard. NT entries will not be accepted for entry.
- Non-Olympic events (stroke 50's and off-distance 1500/800) may not be used as entry into the meet.
- Teams may enter up to 3 relay teams for the 200 FR, 200 MR, 400 FR, and 400 MR for each age category. A maximum of 3 relay teams for each club may be entered for the open 800 FR.
- Qualifying times are included in Hy-Tek Team Manager Event File.
- Deck entries will be accepted at \$16.00 per event provided a new heat is not created and at Meet Management discretion.
- The meet is limited to 500 swimmers.

#### **Proof of Time**

 Proof of times <u>MUST</u> be included for the 800/1500 Free and Female 12&U/Male 13&U 400 free/400 IM. Please use the <u>Team Manager Proof of Time Report</u>.

#### **Submitted Times**

- Long Course times must be submitted for entry.
- Qualifying time must be at or above the Alberta "A" standard (under 12 must use 12 year old A time)
- "Bonus swims" must be at or above the Alberta "B" standard.
- Short Course times may be used for entry and converted using Hy-tek (standard 2%).
- Short Course Yard times may be used for entry and converted using Hy-tek (standard 11.5%)

# **Meet Registration**

- All club officials/coaches are required to register at the Keyano Club office, <u>between 1:30 pm and 5:00 pm on Thursday</u>, May 2, 2013.
- All teams must be registered and have their entry fees paid prior to competing.
- Late registration may be accepted between 7:30 am and 8:30 am on Friday, May 3, 2013.
- Please notify the meet manager if late registration is required.
- Club packages, accreditations and information will be provided at registration.

#### Meet Warm up and Start Times

- · Competition times as follows:
  - Thursday May 2, 2013......3:30pm 4:45pm WU......5:00pm start timed finals
     Friday May 3-Sunday May 5, 2013.....7:30am 8:20am WU......8:30am start prelims
     3:30pm 4:45pm WU......5:00pm start finals
  - Session Reports and Psych sheets will be available at registration and will be posted on www.eksc.com
- The Warm-up/Warm-down pool will be available during warm-ups and the competition.
- Swimmers will have time to warm-down at the end of each session.
- The SNC Warm-up protocol will be in effect and will be posted around the pool.
- Teams requiring **training time** prior to the competition will be provided space on Wed, May 1, 2013 between 4:30 and 7:00 pm. Please contact Scott Wilson (scott095ca@yahoo.ca) if training time and space is required.

# Rules

- SNC and FINA rules will apply.
- SNC warm-up protocol will be in effect
- · The preliminary sessions will be senior seeded.
- · Meet management reserves the right to double-end the meet.
- The final sessions will be swum in the swimmers respective age groups.
  - Females: 12&U, 13-14, 15&O
  - Males: 13&U, 14-15, 16&O
- A Final for Females 12 & U and 13-14, and Males 13 & U and 14-15
- A and B Finals for Females 15 & O and Males 16 & O provided there are at least 30 swimmers entered in the
  event.
- Olympic distance events will swim senior seeded, with the top 10 swimmers swimming in Saturday finals.

## **Positive Check-In**

- Positive Check-in is required for all 800 and 1500 meter events and Female 12&U/Male 13&U 400 meter events by the indicated time.
- Swimmers failing to check in will be scratched from the event.

#### **Scratches**

- As per SNC rule: CSW 3.6.2
- The scratch deadline for timed final events on May 2, 2013 will be up to 4:00 pm.
- The scratch deadline for **heats** on May 3 to 5 shall be thirty (30) minutes **before** the conclusion of the previous night's finals.
- The scratch deadline for **finals** shall be thirty (30) minutes **after** the conclusion of the preliminary heats for finals that day.
- Failure by a swimmer to scratch from a Final in accordance with rule CSW 3.6, constitutes a late scratch, and shall result in the offending swimmer being scratched from all remaining events, including relays, scheduled for that day.
- Scratch cards will be available at the Clerk of Course for preliminaries and finals.

# **Distance Events**

- The open 1500 Free Women and 800 Free Men will be deck seeded, requiring positive check-in at the Clerk of Course by 3:45 pm in order to swim the event. There will be a maximum of 30 swimmers for each event.
- The top 10 fastest LC seed times in the 1500 Fr Women and 800 Fr Men will swim in heat 1. The remaining heats in each event will be swum double-laned alternating women and men.
- The 800 Free Women and 1500 Free Men will be deck seeded, requiring **positive check-in** at the Clerk of Course by **7:45 am**, Saturday, in order to swim the event.
- The top 10 fastest seed times in the 800 Free Women and 1500 Free Men, regardless of age, will be swum in finals.
- The remaining heats will be senior seeded, double-laned and swum fastest to slowest alternating Women and Men to a maximum of 5 heats of the 800 Free women and 4 heats of the 1500 Free men.
- Teams will be informed if their swimmers are not eligible to swim the distance events and they may be entered in an alternative event(s).
- Proof of time is required for Distance events.

#### 400 Free and IM

- The top 40 entries for the 400 Free & 400 IM for Females 12&U, 13-14, 15&O and Males 13&U, 14-15, 16&O will be accepted.
- The Female 12&U, Male 13&U 400 IM and 400 Free are timed final events with the fastest heat of 10 swimming with finals.
- The remaining Female 12&U, Male 13&U in the 400 Free and 400 IM will swim in preliminaries prior to the 13/14&O age group.
- In preliminaries, the Female 13&O, Male 14&O 400 Free and 400 IM will be senior seeded and swum fastest to slowest, alternating women and men.
- If entries for the 400 meter events do not fill as indicated above, then swimmers will be added based on entry time and age group in the following order: Females 15&0 / Males 16&0, Females 13-14/Males 14-15, and Female 12&U/Males 13&U.
- Teams will be informed if their swimmers are not eligible to swim the 400 meter events and they may be entered in an alternative event(s).

#### Relays

- Teams may enter up to 3 relay teams for the 200 FR, 200 MR, 400 FR, and 400 MR for each age category and 3 relay teams for the open 800 FR.
- There are no qualifying times for relays but LC entry times must be included for seeding purposes.
- NT entries for relays will not be accepted.
- Swimmers must be entered in the meet to compete on a relay team.
- Teams entering three relay teams may only score their designated "A" and "B" teams.
- Should one or both designated teams be disqualified, the "C" team is not eligible to score team points.
- Relay cards, with the team names must be submitted to the Clerk of Course by 11:00 AM.
- Changes to the team names/order will be accepted up to 30 minutes prior to the start of the relay events.

## Scoring

- Team Scoring: 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup>: 20-17-15-13-11-9-7-5-3-1
- Relay Scoring: 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup>: 40-34-30-26-22-18-14-10-6-2
- Individual Scoring 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup>: 5-3-1

#### Awards

- Individual Events: Medals for 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> and ribbons from 4<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> for Females 12&U & Males 13&U.
- Relay Events: Medals for 1<sup>st</sup> place team.
- Individual Aggregate Awards: Prizes for high point for each age group (Females 12&U, 13–14, 15-16, Males 13&U, 14-15, 16-17).
- · Prizes for "bell heat" winners.
- Male and Female Swim of the Meet: Trophy presented to the top Male and Female performances based on the FINA point charts.
- Team Awards: Top Team Trophy for large team (20 or more swimmers) and small team (19 or less swimmers).
- Prizes: Prizes will be presented to swimmers breaking Meet Records, Provincial and National Records.
   Prize details will be available at registration.

# **Officials Briefing**

- The officials will meet each day of the competition, one hour prior to the start time of each session. All officials working at that session are required to attend.
- All senior officials may also be required to attend a de-briefing following each session.
