COMPETITION RULES: Sanctioned by Swim Ontario.

All current Swimming/Natation Canada (SNC) rules will be followed.

Please note that Swimming Canada Competition Warm-Up Safety Procedures will be in effect. The

full document can be viewed HERE.

For club and provincial meets, a swimsuit that covers more of the body such as modesty swimwear or religious cover-ups is permitted providing that the fabric is permeable open mesh textile material and does not give the swimmer an advantage. notification or for clarification of interpretation please see the Competition Coordinator.

AGE UP DATE: Ages submitted are to be as: N/A (All events are "Open")

#### MIXED-GENDER:

The host seeks an exemption from the requirement to swim events in gender separated events, on the following basis (choose appropriate circumstances):

 $\boxtimes$  We are holding mixed relays.

Mixed gender swims may also be permitted when, due to a missed swim, it is necessary for a referee to seed a swimmer in a heat of the same or shorter distance, for competitors of the opposite gender, on an exception basis.

In spite of this rule, any swimmer who achieves a record time at any level (regional, provincial, national etc, whether age group or open) will not be recognized for that record unless the coach has advised the referee prior to the start of the session that there is a possibility of the record being broken, and the referee insures that the swimmer competes with competitors of the same gender for his/her heat.

In the event that mixed gender swims are permitted pursuant to this policy, the results must still be posted separately by the gender of swimmers.

#### **ELIGIBILITY:**

All athletes must be registered as Competitive swimmers with SNC, or any other amateur swimming organization recognized by FINA. A valid SNC registration number is required for all Canadian swimmers, and entries without a SNC registration number will be declined entry *(choose appropriate circumstances)*:.

- ☐ This is an invitational meet. Participation of this meet is at the full discretion of the host club.
- ☑ Foreign competitors are welcome, subject to the provisions below.

## FOREIGN COMPETITORS:

All swimmers and coaches must be duly registered and residents of the governing body for which they are competing. All swimmers and coaches must be in good standing with their respective governing swim body.

All swimmers and coaches must have primary residence within the province /state or country for which they claim registration. Proof of residency may be green card, student ID, driver's license, college residence or other document as deemed acceptable by Swim Ontario and shall be submitted with the <a href="Proof of Residence and Registration Status form">Proof of Residence and Registration Status form</a> to Swim Ontario no later than 7 days prior to start of competition.

Entries must be submitted through the SNC online entries system at  $\underline{www.swimming.ca}$  .

Meet Management will not accept entries via email.

- Swimmers may swim maximum of 6 events per session (individual and relay).
- △ A maximum of 3 swimmers per gender per school in events 200m and over.

COACH'S

REGISTRATION: Meet management will cross reference the list of coaches in attendance at this competition with the

<u>Swim Ontario Compliancy lists</u>. If a coach is not on this list, meet management is obligated to enforce the SNC policy and not permit that coach to attend meet. Meet management will forward Swim

Ontario a list of coaches who they have found to be in non-compliance.

COACH'S MEETING: A coaches meeting will be held in the Carleton Pool Back Room at 10:30am.

SEEDING: 

Option "A" (times converted by club and/or host)

Seeding will be in order of times entered,

as converted pursuant to the conversion process as per meet package,

followed by swimmers entered with NT (no times).

TIME SPLITS: Meet management requires that any coach wishing to rely on a time achieved by the swimmer for an

interval shorter than the total distance of the event shall so advise the Referee prior to the

commencement of the session (or event) in question.

DECK ENTRIES: Deck Entries are Exhibition Only. They are not eligible for scoring or awards.

Deck entries will be accepted for empty lanes only (no new heats will be created).

Swimmers entered on deck must have valid proof of SNC registration (number) as an active,

registered, competitive swimmer.

CHECK IN

AND SCRATCHES: 

Scratches are to be made at the clerk of course desk 30 minutes prior to the start of each

session.

SCORING: 

The following will be scored: all events

Individual: points 20, 17, 16, 15, 14, 13, 12, 11, 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 (max 4 per school can score)

Relays: double points (max 4 per school can score)
