

MAVERICK MADNESS

ELIGIBILITY

This competition is open to all swimmers currently registered with Swimming Canada or a FINA affiliated club. Entries will be limited to 300-310 swimmers. Each swimmer is eligible to swim 6 events, 2 per session. A seventh event is allowed for those 11 and over swimmers who would like to swim the 400m freestyle.

FORMAT

- The final session on Saturday night will feature selected events divided into 8&U;
 9;10; 11-12; 13&over. We will offer B-final for the 10 year old age group with events with more than 20 swimmers entered.
- Friday and Saturday sessions will be run as heats and finals (where applicable) and timed finals.
- Sunday's session will be swum as timed finals.
- The 25 & 50 Freestyle will be an eliminator event. The 25 freestyle will be for 10 and under only. Preliminaries will be on Friday evening. The top six (each age group) girls and boys 50 freestyle will swim in session 3. The top six (each age group) 25 Freestyle will be in session 4.
- The 400 Free and 400 IM will be restricted by the amount of heats it creates but we will guarantee swims in certain age groups. Positive check-in for the 400 Free and 400 IM will be required. These events are restricted to 11 and over only.

SAFE SPORT OPERATIONAL STATEMENT

 The Swimming Canada safe sport program will focus on three key areas: education, prevention and response, all of which will be supported by strong governance, policies and procedures. The goal is to ensure that all members and registrants of Swimming Canada, at all levels, have the resources to provide and access a fun, healthy, inclusive and safe environment.

COMPETITION AND DIVING READINESS STANDARDS

 Entry to the competition is limited to participants who have passed Swim Alberta's Competition Swim Test. During competition, swimmers should dive at the Dive Readiness Progression skill level they have achieved.

MEET RULES

- The meet will be conducted under published FINA and/or WPS rules and regulations supplemented by published and approved Swimming Canada and Swim Alberta rules and regulations. Swim Alberta policies and procedures, where appropriate will also apply.
- The Swim Alberta Scratch Rule will be in effect for this competition.
- Meet management reserves the right to modify the meet program to allow for the maximum number of swims within the time allotted as per Swim Alberta's sessions guidelines.
- Relay entries with complete swimmer names are due to the Clerk of Course by the end of the prior session.

DIVING RULES

 Starts will be conducted from Starting Platforms (blocks) as per FINA FR 2.3 and SW 4.1.

ENTRY LIMIT

- The approximate total number of available entries for this meet is 1800. Approximately 440 entries will be reserved for the Mavericks.
- Swimmers are limited to a maximum of 6 individual events, maximum 2 per sessions. A 7th event will be allowed if the swimmer wants to swim the 400 Free.
- Deck entries will be limited to swimmers who have registered for the competition through the Swimming Canada online system. (www.swimming.ca)
- Deck entries will be accepted provided that extra heats are not created.
- All Deck Entries are exhibition swims, and will not be scored. Deck entries will
 cost \$20.00 for individual events and \$30.00 for relays and be paid at the time of
 request for a deck entry.

ENTRIES

• Entry fees will be \$10.00 for timed final events, \$12.00 for events with heats and finals, and \$20.00 for relays.

- All entries must be submitted through the Swimming Canada online system.
- Cheques should be made payable to Okotoks Mavericks Swimming.
