Format: Timed finals

Eligibility: All swimmers must be registered with Swim BC or other FINA affiliated organization.

SWAD (swimmers with a disability) are welcome. Please designate the classification with the entries.

Entries:

1. Swimmers must achieve a 4:00 200 IM and 5:40 300 FREE to be eligible. Please submit proof of times.
2. All Athletes must have the 9 digit Swim BC identification number.
3. Age groups will be based upon the first day of competition.
4. Entries must be submitted on HYTEK to swimmeet.ca.
5. We will not be accepting swimmers with "NT" in the 200 I.M.
6. Deck entries will be permitted if space available. No new heats will be added after scratch deadline.
7. Deck entries and deck scratches will be accepted 30 minutes prior to the start of the meet.

Fees:

1. \$4.00 Swim BC splash fee
2. \$4.50 Individual events
3. \$6.50 Relays
4. Deck entries: \$10.00 Individual, \$15.00 Relay
5. Please make cheques payable to Surrey Knights Swim Club

Distances Event Standards:

1. BC 'A' standard in the 200 free to swim the 400 free.
2. BC 'A' standard in the 400 free to swim the 800 or 1500 free.
3. BC 'A' standard in the 200 I.M. to swim the 400 I.M.
4. All distance events will be limited and will be based on date of entry.
5. 400, 800 and 1500 Freestyle events will be double-laned based on number of entries.

Competition Rules:

1. All SNC and Swim BC rules as stated in the SNC rulebook and Swim BC Technical Guide will apply.
2. All LMR rules will be in effect
3. 10 & Under swimmers are limited to 4 hours of competition time.
4. FINA one-start rule will be in effect
5. There will be no diving in warm-up with the exception of Safety Marshal and sprint lanes

Timers:

1. Each club is responsible for 3 timers per session.
2. All clubs must provide 2 timers for each swimmer entered in the 800 & 1500 Freestyle events.

Concessions:

1. Java Hut bakery and cafe on site
2. Tim Horton's across the parking lot.

Coach's Meeting: There will be a coach's meeting 10 minutes prior to the start of the competition if needed.

Officials Meeting: There will be an officials meeting 20 minutes prior to the start of each session.

Awards:

1. Relay and Individual ribbons (1st – 8th place) will be awarded in each age category according to Swim BC guidelines.
2. B.C. Provincial Age Group Qualifiers (AAA's) may enter but will not be eligible for awards.

Results: Results will be available on the swim BC web site by May 15, 2008.

Meet Officials:

- These are minimum requirements only. More help on deck will be appreciated.

The names of the stroke and turn or other deck officials must be submitted to the official's manager by **Monday May 7, 2008** with the names of your experienced deck officials and trainees.

The referee will make stroke and turn assignments during the officials meeting. This meeting will take place 20 minutes prior to the session start at the pool.

Clubs will be assigned lanes for timing according to each club's meet entry load. The lane assignment will be posted on the deck during each session. Please remind your parents that the lanes must be manned through to the end of the meet.
