- All events will be "senior-seeded" for prelims.
- Age groups for finals will be 11&U, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16&O.
 - Ages with fewer than 8 finalists in an event may be combined with other under-subscribed ages
- Swimmer age is as of the first day of competition.
- Swimmers cannot swim in an "older" age if they have a "AAA" time in their current age, EXCEPT for swimmers who have a birthday (and thus change ages) between June 25 and July 8, inclusive.
 - Swimmers in this situation are disqualified from this meet if they have a "AAA" time in the older age group.
- Meet management reserves the right to challenge any entry time prior to or during the competition. It is the responsibility of the club to prove any entry times if requested.

NON-QUALIFIED SWIMS

- Every swimmer with at least one qualifying time may enter up to EIGHT individual events.
- For 400 freestyle and 400 IM, meet management reserves the right to swim any/all non-qualified entries in overflow heats to be run Senior-seeded, fastest to slowest, at the conclusion of the heats (after 800/1500 events), provided time permits. i.e. There is no guarantee that non-qualified 400m entries will swim.
- Non-qualified entries in the 800 and 1500 will be accepted only to fill the slowest heat in each event.
- "NT" entries will not be accepted in any events; swimmers must have a valid proveable entry time in each event they enter.

ENTRIES

- Individual entries are limited to a maximum of nine per swimmer; to enter nine events, the swimmer must have the qualifying time in all nine events.
- Proof of time is required for all qualifying events. Please email proof of time report for your club to entries coordinator, Michelle Harrison: mharrison1976@gmail.com.
- CUSTOM TIMES ARE NOT ACCEPTED.
- Entries must include relay names along with the relay entries. Relay swimmers may be changed at the meet.
- Entry fees are **\$8.00 per individual event** and **\$9.50 per relay event**, plus a \$4/swimmer SwimBC Provincial Team Splash Fee.
- Cheques payable to: **Surrey Knights Swim Club**
 - All fees MUST be paid prior to the start of the meet.**

ELIGIBILITY

See also SPECIAL MEET RULES below.

- All swimmers must be registered with a Swim BC, SNC, USS or other FINA recognized club.
- As of the entry deadline, athletes must have attained at least ONE 2009-2010 BC AA short course or long course qualifying time in an appropriately sanctioned competition, AND must not have attained a AAA time in their age group.**



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SPECIAL MEET RULES

SCRATCHES – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

1. There is no scratch penalty for no-shows, step downs and unexcused incomplete swims during prelims.
2. For all finals sessions, no-shows, step downs and unexcused incomplete swims will all be considered a late scratch.
3. The initial scratch deadline for finals each night will be 30 minutes following the completion of morning preliminaries, excluding any 800/1500 or “overflow” heats
4. The last scratch deadline for finals will be 30 minutes prior to the start of the finals session.
5. Late scratches (as defined above) from finals will be subject to the late scratch penalty of \$20, plus removal from all other events, including relays, on that day. In addition, no other member of the offending swimmer’s team shall compete in a final until the \$20 penalty has been paid.

GENERAL

1. This meet will observe rules as outlined in the current SNC Rulebook and Swim BC Tech Guide.
2. Deck entries and Exhibition Swims are not permitted.
3. There will be no time trials.
4. SNC warm-up procedures apply. No diving into pool until sprint lanes are announced approximately 30 minutes prior to the conclusion of warm-ups.
5. Preliminaries and finals will be swum in the event order as outlined in the meet event list.
6. All events will be senior-seeded slowest to fastest for prelims, with ages broken out for finals.
7. The 400m finals will be swum as 11-12, 13-14, 15&O, with four swimmers from each age in the final. (e.g. the 11-12 final will feature four 11-year-olds and four 12-year-olds).
8. Coaches are asked to check in with the Meet Manager immediately upon arrival to pay entry fees, pick up Meet Package and receive information regarding any changes.
9. A coaches’ meeting will be held 10 minutes prior to the start of heats on Friday and as necessary.
10. Should it become necessary to change warm-up and/or starting times, coaches will be notified as soon as possible.
11. Clubs are asked to submit names of timers and session availability along with entries. Clubs will be contacted by Meet Officials Chairperson for other deck officials.
12. Any act of theft, vandalism or similar action will result in immediate disqualification from the meet.
13. Swim BC and meet management reserve the right to make changes to the meet format as needed to try to ensure a quality competition.

SCORING

1. There will be no team or individual scoring.

800 – 1500 Freestyle

1. The 800 & 1500 freestyle events will be swum as timed finals, with all qualified swimmers seeded fastest to slowest.
2. All age groups will swim on Friday; however, if desired timelines on Friday cannot be met, slower heats that cannot be completed on Friday will be swum on Saturday at the conclusion of prelims.
3. The scratch deadline will be 10:00am for the events on that day.
4. Any scratches (as defined in SCRATCHES section previously) after the 10:00am scratch deadline will be treated the same as a late scratch from finals with the same penalties.
5. Awards will still be presented in the individual age categories as outlined earlier
6. Meet management reserves the right to swim these events two-swimmers-per-lane.
7. Swimmers in 800/1500 must provide at least one timer per lane
8. Only those swimmers meeting the qualifying time in these events will be assured the opportunity to swim; non-qualified entries will be accepted to fill empty lanes in the slowest heats.

Relays

1. Only the fastest eight proved relay entries in each event will swim as timed finals at the conclusion of finals sessions. All other relay heats will swim as a timed final at the end of the preliminaries session.
2. There will be no qualifying times for relays.
3. There will be no maximum number of teams per club for relay entries.
4. Only swimmers whose names appear on the meet entries shall compete in relay events.
5. Please specify relay team swimmer assignments with entries. Clubs will have the opportunity to change relay swimmers.
6. Swimmers who will be in relays only must be listed in their club’s Hytek entry file as “Relay only swimmers”, and cannot have a “AAA” time. An email should also be sent to the entries coordinator notifying them of the relay-only swimmer and their SNC ID number and date of birth. These swimmers are subject to Swim BC Splash Fee.
7. Swimmers cannot compete in a relay event in an age/age group in which they have a AAA time.

AWARDS

1. Medals will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in all individual and relay events with four or more entries.
2. Ribbons will be awarded for 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th places in individual events only.
